LITERACY

Reading:

We will learn all about books and how to interact with texts. This includes identifying initial alphabet letter-sounds and using this knowledge to segment and blend words to read them. We will learn heart words commonly seen in texts and through engaging with quality picture books; we will learn new vocabulary and develop our oral language skills.

LITERACY

Writing:

We will learn the correct way to hold our pencils and work to strengthen our fine and gross motor skills to grow our writing stamina.

To ensure that we can write fluently, we will learn to start our letters in the correct place, and use correct letter formation. As the term progresses we will look at sentences and how we go about writing these.

PHYSICAL

We will learn and engage in fun activities that promote the development of fundamental movement skills such as walking, running, jumping, landing and balancing.

We will take part in fun brain breaks that involve moving sensibly and following instructions.

OUR LEARNING

THE ARTS

Visual:

We will explore using different techniques in Art to respond to our inquiry topic in creative and interesting ways.

Performing arts:

In Drama we will learn about acting out scenarios and parts of our stories.

In Music we will learn about the pitch of sounds; loud and soft. In Dance, we will perform a routine that can be enjoyed by an audience.

INQUIRY

School values:

At the beginning of the term, we will explore our three school values and what it means to act in ways that show these values. **Science:**

Later in the term, we will be looking at the parts of a tree and more specifically the structure and function of leaves. **Technology:**

We will design and build bug

motels to encourage important insect life to our school environment.

Warkworth Library:

To support our learning about books and reading, we will visit the Warkworth Library and enjoy looking at the variety of texts that are available for us to engage with.
