

## Miro Community Pānui/Notice - Term Two, 2024



### Welcome to Term 2:

Welcome back to all of our learners and their families. We are looking forward to the term ahead and new exciting learning opportunities. Below is a brief summary of our learning focus for Term 2.

#### Science (The Living World) and New Zealand Histories:

This term's learning focus is 'Ngāhere Kaitiaki - Guardians of Our Forest', which builds on our knowledge of the local area. Our focus is to understand what ecosystems we have in Warkworth and why these are important to our ngāhere. The aim is to become a kaitiaki of our local forest.

#### During this learning journey our key questions will be:

- What Māori pūrākau do we have about the ngāhere and what is showing the value of kaitiaki?
- What is a food chain and how are food chains affected if something is removed?
- What is an ecosystem?
- What food chains and ecosystems do we have present at our kura?
- Why are ecosystems so important to our environment at Warkworth?

#### Literacy:

This term, our focus will be on non-fiction texts, refining our ability to identify main ideas and record information accurately. We will develop our writing skills, moving through note-taking, drafting, editing, and publishing to communicate effectively, with a particular emphasis on crafting informative reports.

The structured reading programme will build students' confidence and strengthen their phonological awareness for decoding.

#### Mathematics:

Our two major areas of focus are Number and Measurement. Students will develop multiplication and division skills to enhance their understanding of fractions. They will explore measurement concepts in real-world contexts, within the C4 production.

#### The Arts: Performing Arts / Visual Art

Dance will be a major focus in the Arts this term. With the support of a specialised dance teacher, students will explore through movement the dance elements of body awareness, space, time, energy and relationships in preparation for our upcoming production.

A community art project will be run by Nicole Callender focusing on sketching techniques and using water colour paint.

#### Health and P.E

Food and nutrition, along with healthy eating, will be our health focus this term. As part of our Physical Education programme, students will develop skills to invade and defend space in games.

#### **Home Learning**

Reading remains the priority for home learning. Students may select their own book from our school library or the pick n mix boxes each week. The expectation is to read for 20-30 minutes daily. Heart words will be sent out this term for spelling practise.
